Diacoustic Medical Devices (Pty) Ltd. (Diacoustic) is committed to safeguarding your privacy online. Please read the following Privacy Policy to understand how your personal information will be treated as you make full use of the TeleSensi Website and Application ("TeleSensi Services"). The TeleSensi Website is owned and operated by Diacoustic Medical Devices (Pty) Ltd.

1. **CONSENT.** By using the TeleSensi Services, you consent to the collection and use of the information as described here. If we decide to make changes to this Privacy Policy, we will post the changes on this page so that you will always know what information we collect, and how we use it. By using the **TeleSensi Services** subsequent to such changes, you consent to them. The last date the Privacy Policy was revised is set forth above.
2. **GATHERING AND USE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION.** Diacoustic does not collect personally identifying information about any individual except when knowingly provided on as part of **TeleSensi Services**. If you do not want us to collect any personal information, do not submit it to us. If you choose not to provide the information we request, you can still visit most of the **TeleSensi Services**, but you may be unable to access certain options and services. Your personal information may be stored and used by Diacoustic to provide services to you and to contact you with respect to transactions conducted through the **TeleSensi Services**. We will not sell, rent or disclose your personal information to our business partners, suppliers, vendors or other third parties without notifying you of our intent to share the information and giving you an opportunity to prevent your information from being shared. We may, however, disclose information about our users when we believe, in good faith, that the disclosure is required by law.
3. **GATHERING BROWSER LEVEL INFORMATION.** Our web server hosting the **TeleSensi Services** automatically collects information about a site user's IP address, browser type and referrer (collectively, "Browser Level Information") by reading this information from the user's browser (information provided by every user's browser). We store and use Browser Level Information, in the aggregate only, to diagnose problems with our Web server, to improve and track the success of the **TeleSensi Services** and to provide content of interest to you. Browser Level Information is automatically logged by most Websites. We may share Browser Level Information with advertisers or other third parties, including our business partners, suppliers, and vendors, on an aggregated basis without revealing any personally identifiable information and without the consent of any user.
4. **USE OF COOKIES.** The **TeleSensi Services** may use cookies solely to track user traffic patterns throughout **TeleSensi Services**. Cookies are small electronic files that a website may transfer to the user's computer, and are used for record-keeping purposes. A cookie file can contain information, such as a user identification code, that the site uses to track the pages you have visited. Most Web site browsers automatically accept cookies; however, if you would prefer not to receive cookies, your browser can be set to warn you before accepting cookies and refuse the cookie when your browser alerts you to its presence.
